

Cynomolgus Serum Albumin Protein

Description

Source	Recombinant Cynomolgus Serum Albumin Protein is expressed from HEK293 with His tag at the C-Terminus. It contains Asp25-Ala608.
Accession	A2V9Z4-1
Molecular Weight	The protein has a predicted MW of 67.1 kDa. Due to glycosylation, the protein migrates to 68-70 kDa based on Bis-Tris PAGE result.
Endotoxin	Less than 1 EU per μg by the LAL method.
Purity	> 95% as determined by Bis-Tris PAGE > 95% as determined by HPLC

Formulation and Storage

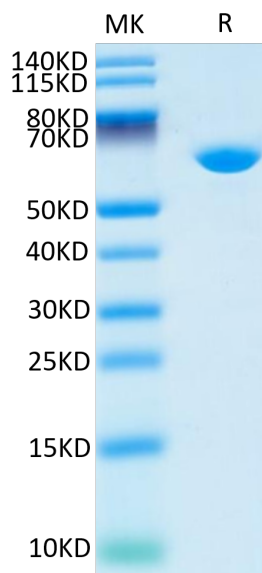
Formulation	Lyophilized from 0.22 μm filtered solution in PBS (pH 7.4). Normally 8% trehalose is added as protectant before lyophilization.
Reconstitution	Centrifuge the tube before opening. Reconstituting to a concentration more than 100 $\mu\text{g}/\text{ml}$ is recommended. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in distilled water.
Storage	-20 to -80°C for 12 months as supplied from date of receipt. -80°C for 3 months after reconstitution. Recommend to aliquot the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage. Please minimize freeze-thaw cycles.

Background

Albumins are multifunctional proteins present in the blood serum of animals. They can bind and transport a wide variety of ligands which they accommodate due to their conformational flexibility. Serum albumins are highly conserved both in amino acid sequence and three-dimensional structure. Several mammalian and avian serum albumins (SAs) are also allergens. Sensitization to one of the SAs coupled with the high degree of conservation between SAs may result in cross-reactive antibodies in allergic individuals.

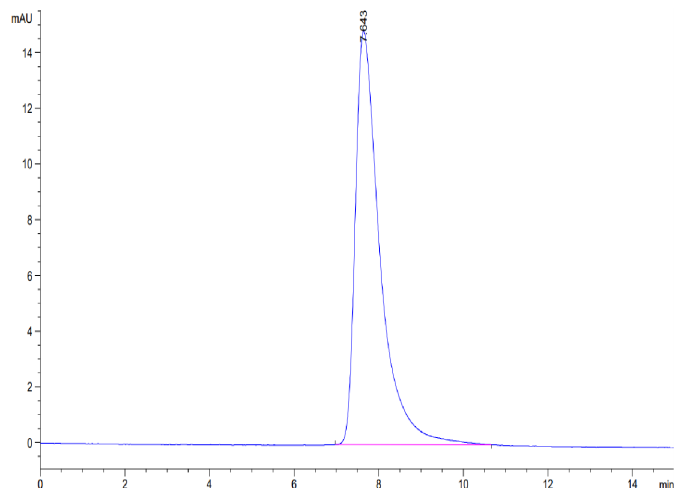
Bis-Tris PAGE



Cynomolgus Serum Albumin on Bis-Tris PAGE under reduced condition. The purity is greater than 95%.

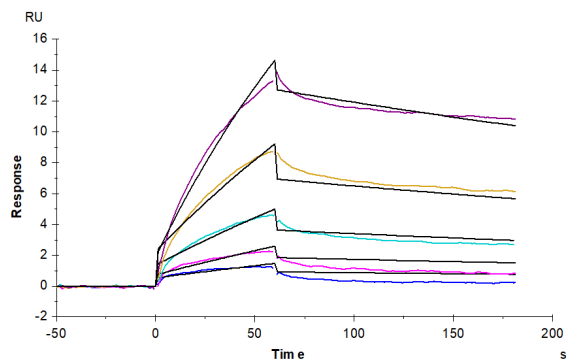
SEC-HPLC

SPR Data



Cynomolgus Serum Albumin, His Tag immobilized on CM5 Chip can bind Cynomolgus/Rhesus macaque FcRn, His Tag with an affinity constant of 0.108 μ M as determined in SPR assay (Biacore T200).
